

Who is a genuine star?

If we just met and I told you I was a star, what would you think my profession was? You would assume I was a famous actress!

We can be stars in the eyes of the Lord and in the eyes of the universe. How much greater honor that is than being a worldly star! What a wonderful privilege and gift of God that is!

- ❖ Print pages 3 - 8 back to back on white paper
- ❖ Print page 9 or 10 on a 4.25" x 9.5" envelope (depending on the type of printer you have, page 9 if envelope loads on the right side of the printer, or page 10 if printer loads envelope in the center)
- ❖ Fold appeal in 3 even sections (Z-Fold -- artwork out on top section)
- ❖ Fold set of quotes in 3 even sections (Z-Fold -- artwork out on top section)
- ❖ Place 1 appeal, 1 set of quotes in each envelope.
- ❖ PLEASE!!! Hand out and/or mail to all church members, Christian family members and friends!
